Sept 19 10-12 noon	<u>Understanding Radon Risk and Health Effects</u> 2 Hours CE for Kansas 2 Hours Cat II CE AARST-NRPP This course will cover the factors which are fundamental to understanding personal and population exposures and what the impacts are for individuals and society in terms of health care costs and risk reduction.	\$25
Sept 19 1-5 p.m.	<u>HUD and Multi-family Housing Radon Testing Requirements</u> 4 Hours CE for Kansas 4 Hours Cat I CE AARST-NRPP This updated course will serve the education and exam requirements of the new add-on Multi-Family Radon certificate program of AARST-NRPP developed in response to HUD policy announcements in February 2013. It will cover key issues of documentation, liability, standards and process needed to make accurate, valid, and defensible radon measurements in multi-family buildings. Demand for these services is anticipated to grow in 2013.	\$50
